Re: Formal Request for Written Parental Notice Required by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)

Dear Educators:

This letter is my formal request for my written prior notice.

I have been advised that to meet the requirements of the IDEA its regulations (34 C.F.R. § 300.503), your written notice must contain all of the following elements:

- a description of the action that is being proposed or refused;
- an explanation of why the agency proposes or refuses to take action;
- a description of any other options the agency considered and the reasons why those options were rejected;
- a description of each evaluation procedure, assessment, record, or report that the agency is using as a basis for the their decision; and
- a description of any other factors that are relevant to the agency's proposal or refusal.
